RE:	Tetra Tech Right-of-Way permit approval

BACKGROUND

Hydrite contracts groundwater study and remediation work through Tetra Tech. They are seeking a right-of-way permit to install temporary monitoring wells and soil gas probes near the intersection of Yarrow Hill Dr. and Trillium Trl.

OVERVIEW

Tetra Tech has a number of monitoring wells in the Village ROW and have always been very responsible and responsive actors when there is an issue, question or concern from our Department. They provide groundwater flow information, not only to Hydrite, but to us as well and I have never had any issue working with them either inside the ROW or out. The proposed wells are only temporary for short term investigation and will be flush mounted. The soil gas probes will also be temporary and small. The plan also shows installation of wells in Huston Park. Our Parks, Recreation and Forestry Director reviewed the plans and sees no issue with these placements either.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

I propose that Board authorize issuance of this ROW permit to Tetra Tech for temporary monitoring well and soil gas probe installation.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

At the July 2nd meeting the Public Works & Properties Committee unanimously recommended approval with the stipulation that the plan is communicated to the three properties closest to the planned temporary installations.
