Mark made a motion to approve the minutes from 7/20/21's meeting as written. David seconded. Motion passed 2-0 with Jill abstaining.

Claudia discussed open & pending cases. 5 total cases. 1 successfully closed and 4 still open. Things are slow right now around Sun Prairie and Madison. 1-2 cases per week in those municipalities.

Grant has been approved. Undergoing implementation. Goal to service 120 youths. There will be training soon. Jill asked if there was any documentation around the grant. Jay will be back next week and will determine what info can be provided to Jill.
