Innovation grant was approved and found someone from Milwaukee (Restorative Circles - link to bios: <https://restorativecircles.net/our-people/>) who is coming to do a 2-day training next month.

A \$2K grant was used to host Global Youth Justice for a 9/11 event. Not all the funds were used, and they reached out to Claudia to use the funds to travel to Boston for the 20th Global Youth Justice training.

Claudia recommended producing a prevention guide. Claudia mentioned that Cottage Grove has a townhall meeting every month hosted by the Police Department to get community wide involvement.
