

12/19/2022 Teacher Student with IEP (if known) A teacher was asking for help with a student in their classroom. I was with one of the school counselors and they asked if I could come with in case they needed more support. I walked to the room and stayed around the corner so the student could not see me. I was not needed, and I left.

12/19/2022 Officer (non-enforcement) I assisted during the lunch hours as we were short staffed.

12/19/2022 Teacher A teacher reported they smelled what they believed to be marijuana in the 8th grade hallway. By the time I got to the hallway, the smell had dissipated.

12/20/2022 Teacher I taught two 6th grade health classes teaching online safety.

12/20/2022 Family I was contacted by a parent who was given a citation for disorderly conduct who is continuously calling asking for information. This parent has been told several times that she needs to follow proper procedure and request a copy of the report.

1/3/2023 Teacher A teacher came to me and reported that a student had taken something out of a locker and then threw it down the hallway. I was able to find the surveillance footage and it was reported to administration by the teacher via email.

1/3/2023 Officer (non-enforcement) I heard Officer Koratko get dispatched to Taylor Prairie School for a fire alarm. I responded to the school, and it was believed the alarm was due to a bad detector in the kitchen. Fire cleared the building and deemed it safe for students and staff to re-enter.

1/3/2023 Family I was told by the front office staff that a parent called saying that their child's cellphone was pinging at an apartment on Main Street on Cottage Grove. The front office told me that the student was in school, but the parent was concerned about the phone location. The student was called to the office, and she checked her locker. Her phone was in her locker. I called the parent back and learned that the app that they use had to refresh and it was now showing at the school.

1/4/2023 Officer (non-enforcement) I attended the weekly SS/Admin meeting

1/4/2023 Administration Kris Langer and I met with a female student who was reported to be harassing another student. We learned that this has been going on approximately all year. I told the student not to have contact with the other student and informed her of possible consequences.

1/4/2023 Administration I was asked to look up video surveillance footage of a fight in the 7th grade hallway. I found the incident and showed it to administration.

1/4/2023 Administration I was asked to look at video surveillance for a fight in the gym. I found the footage and showed it to administration.

1/4/2023 Administration I was asked to check video of the Encore girls bathroom for three girls who were hiding in the bathroom. I did not see behavior that appeared to be "hiding" as they were not in the bathroom longer than what is usually appropriate.

1/4/2023 Teacher I was asked to check video of the Encore girls bathroom for two girls hiding. I found the footage and they were intentionally hiding in the bathroom as they would come out and go back in several times and were there for almost an hour. Administration was notified.

1/4/2023 Family I received a phone call from one of the parents involved with the incident earlier regarding the two students. The parent wanted to file a police report to have one on file in case things continue and/or escalate. I contacted the other student's parent and informed them of the complaint and that I had talked with their child. They said that they would talk to their child as well.

1/5/2023 Family I was contacted by a parent that I had talked to the previous day regarding her child being harassed. She had some more information and requested that I talk with her son. I talked with her son, and he gave me some more names of students that have been bothering him.

1/5/2023 Administration A student had slipped on water in the hallway and another student had slipped and fell and injured themselves. I found the incident and administration talked to the student involved.

1/5/2023 Teacher A teacher came to my office and said that he walked into the 8th grade boys bathroom and it smelled like marijuana. I checked the camera footage and found two boys that were in there. The boys were talked to by me and Mr. Kamoku and both denied doing anything in the bathroom. The lockers were searched by Mr. Kamoku and no contraband was located.

1/6/2023 Student A student said that someone had "smacked" her butt after lunch on Wednesday. I was able to look at the video footage and saw that it was unintentional as the kid was running and squeezed between two other students and the reporting student.

1/6/2023      Family              In the morning I was notified that there was a voicemail message for the school the previous night at approximately 7pm. The message stated, "I am going to sue you". Someone thought that it might have said "I am going to shoot you". I listened to the message and was able to hear the word "sue". The phone number was on the caller ID and a quick check of the number gave the name of an 8th grade student. Mr. Kamoku and I talked with the student who admitted to making the phone call and said that he said "sue".

1/6/2023      Student              Student of Color              A student that I know came to the office for a break. His pass was signed for Mr. Verhage, but Mr. Verhage was busy, so the student stayed with me. We talked and he asked about what it was like being a police officer. He asked if I knew about the Shop with a Cop program, and I told him I did. He said that he remembered when he went with the Monona Police Department. We looked and were able to find two photographs of him shopping with the now retired Chief of Police. He said that he wished his mom could see those photographs. I printed them off for him and he was so happy.

1/9/2023      Family              Student of Color              A parent of a student contacted me via email wanting to report her student's AirPods stolen the week before Christmas break during a class. The AirPods were showing at an address in the City of Sun Prairie. The parent said that their child was sure that the AirPods were stolen during a specific class. I checked the addresses of the kids in that class and none of them matched the address where the AirPods were pinging. I asked the parent if we could get an updated location for the AirPods as the one she sent me was from December 30th. She said that she would have her child check when she got home from school and then get back to me.

1/9/2023      Teacher              A teacher reported that she found a door that was not closed all the way and she closed it. I went and checked the door and there was nothing in the way of the door that would prevent it from closing. I opened the door, and it came back with good force and latched with no issues. I will keep an eye on this door. Custodial staff was informed as well.

1/9/2023      Student              Student of Color              I was walking through the cafeteria during the late afternoon and a student was in the community room. I didn't see them, but they saw me as I walked by the door and called out my name. They came out into the cafeteria with me, and I talked with them for a while before getting a hug from this student.

1/10/2023      Officer (non-enforcement)              Attended the monthly SRO meeting at the Cottage Grove Village Hall

1/11/2023      Student              Student of Color              A student came to the office first thing in the morning and reported an incident with another student and the student's parent. The student said that as they were walking to basketball practice, the student and their mother slowly drove past the group walking to practice and "flipped" them off before driving away. The student in the vehicle had reported being bullied by one of the girls walking. Ms. Langer and I contacted the student from the vehicle, and I contacted the mother and warned her for her and her son's actions. The parent denied "flipping" off anyone but said she drove that way to go home and said she slowed down when her child pointed

out the other student. She admitted that it was not smart on her part to do that. She was warned against further behavior like this and was told to stay away from the student.

1/11/2023 Administration Kris Langer received an email from Culvers saying that several middle school girls were at Culvers after the choir concert and were screaming in the bathroom. When the employee asked them to stop screaming, they told the employee "Get off your period and start cutting yourself". Follow up will be conducted and the girls will be talked with, and parents contacted.

1/11/2023 Administration I was asked to sit with a student in my office during his lunch for a detention. He sat with me, and we talked before he was allowed to go back to class.

1/12/2023 Administration Student with IEP (if known) I was asked if a student could sit with me during their lunch. The student had a plan that they did not have to sit in the lunchroom and could have an alternate space. The student was sitting with Mr. Verhage, but Mr. Verhage needed to attend to a different matter. The student sat with me in my office until their lunch time was over. This is a student whom I have a great relationship with and unfortunately have had to physically remove from the bus. This student is not afraid of me and is comfortable being with me. We talked and he helped me with a task I was working on. He wanted something to do so I gave him a small job. When his lunch was over, he said goodbye and went back to class.

1/12/2023 Officer (non-enforcement) I had to leave school shortly before 1pm to go to the police department to have a meeting with the Chief. Prior to the meeting, there was a police incident that occurred that I was requested to assist with. I assisted by transporting a suspect to the police department from the scene until I was relieved and was able to meet with the Chief.
