



Cottage Grove Police K-9 Monthly Report

April 2025

April 3, 2025

- On April 3, 2025, at approximately 1853 hours Officer Tapp of the Cottage Grove Police Department conducted a traffic stop located at W Cottage Grove Rd and W Oak St in the Village of Cottage Grove and Requested Officer Ace and K9 Nash to the scene. K9 Nash was deployed and conducted an open-air sniff around the vehicle for illegal narcotics. No final indication observed.

April 3, 2025

- On April 3, 2025, at approximately 1936 hours Officer Tapp of the Cottage Grove Police Department conducted a traffic stop located at E Oak St and N Main St in the Village of Cottage Grove and Requested Officer Ace and K9 Nash to the scene. K9 Nash was deployed and conducted an open-air sniff around the vehicle for illegal narcotics. No final indication observed.

April 4, 2025

- On April 4, 2025, at approximately 1853 hours Officer Johnson of the Cottage Grove Police Department conducted a traffic stop located at N Main St and Commerce Pkwy in the Village of Cottage Grove and Requested Officer Ace and K9 Nash to the scene. K9 Nash was deployed and conducted an open-air sniff around the vehicle for illegal narcotics. No final indication observed.

April 4, 2025

- On April 4, 2025, at approximately 1926 hours Officer Greenwald of the Cottage Grove Police Department conducted a traffic stop located at N Main St and W Parkview St in the Village of Cottage Grove and Requested Officer Ace and K9 Nash to the scene. K9 Nash was deployed and conducted an open-air sniff around the vehicle for illegal narcotics. K9 Nash provided a final indication on the vehicle. The vehicle was searched but no illegal narcotics were located.

April 2025

April 6, 2025,

- On April 6, 2025, at approximately 2042 hours the Dane County Sheriff's Department conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle engaging in suspicious activity located in Cambridge at the intersection on W Water St and W Main St. Officer Ace and K9 Nash arrived on scene and K9 Nash was deployed to conduct an exterior open-air sniff for illegal narcotics. K9 Nash provided a final indication on the passenger side door, which led to the arrest of the passenger who had warrants. The Dane County Sheriff's Department conducted a search for the vehicle, but no illegal narcotics were seized. The driver of the vehicle admitted to having illegal narcotics in the passenger side glove compartment of the vehicle two days prior.

April 7, 2025,

- On April 7, 2025, at approximately 1239 hours, Officer Ace conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle located at 421 W Cottage Grove Rd and requested Officer Gilmore to assist while K9 Nash was deployed conducting an open-air sniff for illegal narcotics. K9 Nash was deployed, and no final indication was observed.

April 7, 2025,

- On April 7, 2025, at approximately 1832 hours, Officer Phillips of the Cottage Grove Police Department observed an open door to a residence that was listed for sale and vacant within the Village of Cottage Grove. Officer Ace and K9 Nash arrived on scene and K9 Nash was utilized to conduct a building search for unwanted people. No people were in the residence and the building was secured upon leaving.

April 7, 2025,

- On April 7, 2025, at approximately 1930 hours, Officer Phillips of the Cottage Grove Police Department observed an open door to a residence that was listed for sale and vacant within the Village of Cottage Grove. Officer Ace and K9 Nash arrived on scene and K9 Nash was utilized to conduct a building search for unwanted persons. No people were in the residence and the building was shut upon leaving.

April 13, 2025,

- On April 13, 2025 at approximately 2018 hours Officer Tapp of the Cottage Grove Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle located at N Main St and Progress Dr in the Village of Cottage Grove and requested Officer Ace and K9 Nash to the scene. K9 Nash was deployed to conduct an exterior vehicle sniff for illegal narcotics. No behavioral changes were observed.

April 16, 2025,

- On April 16, 2025, at approximately 1416 hours the Madison Police Department requested Officer Ace and K9 Nash to the address of 726 Vernon Ave Apt 1 in the City of Madison to conduct track of a suspect who was attempting to break into the residence. A track started at the residence then picked up where the suspect jumped a fence. While Officer Ace was relocating to the other side of the fence, the suspect was apprehended by Madison Police Department.

April 16, 2025

- On April 16, 2025, at approximately 1856 hours Officer Ace and K9 Nash along with Officer Philips of the Cottage Grove Police Department were notified of an open patio door to a residence located within the Village of Cottage Grove. After the Officer's spoke with the owners of the residence, it was learned that no one should be in the residence. K9 Nash was utilized to clear the residence. No people were located.

April 21, 2025,

- On April 21, 2025, at 1555 hours Officer Ace and K9 Nash were requested to conduct an exterior vehicle sniff for illegal narcotics at a traffic stop that State Patrol had conducted on I94 W/B at 242.8. K9 Nash was deployed and detailed around the vehicle in a low manner. No behavioral changes were observed.

April 21, 2025,

- On April 21, 2025, at approximately 2138 hours, Officer Ace and K9 Nash responded to 300 Commerce Pkwy for an alarm along with Officer Evan Tapp. While on scene, a door was observed to be partially open. Officer Ace attempted to contact the key holder but was unable to. K9 Nash was utilized to conduct a building search for unwanted people. K9 Nash was deployed and searched for the building. No people were located, and the business was locked prior to leaving.
