Draft - Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

The May 28, 2019 regular meeting of the Village of Cottage Grove Law Enforcement was called to order at 5:32 p.m. by Village President John Williams

2. Determination of quorum and that the agenda was properly posted

It was determined that there was a quorum of members present and that the agenda properly posted. Committee members present were: Police Chief Dan Layber, Member Ron Mabie, Trustee Sarah Valencia and John Williams with Trustee Jon Russell and Member Kishia Peters both excused absence. Also in attendance was Lieutenant Matthew Wagner.

3. Discuss and consider the approval of the previous meeting minutes

Motion by Valencia to table the approval of the previous meeting minutes as they were not included in the packet and seconded by Mabie. Motion carried with a voice vote of 3-0-0.

4. New Business

- a. Search warrant update Maria Lane: Chief Layber updated the committee on the of execution of the search warrant, suspect arrested with drugs, cash, and weapon seized, and request to evict the residents who have left the property.
- b. Asset forfeiture update: Chief Layber shared that the funds, approximately \$13K, need to be released before considering what to do with them as timing is unknown. At that point, he would come back to this committee with a proposal (e.g. surveillance video equipment) of how to utilize these funds which are not to be used to supplement general operation.
- c. Fireman's Festival planning update: Chief Layber indicated that the department had extra officers for Hot2Trot race, parade and overall festival along with typical patrols. This is addition to security for instance in the beer tents.
- d. Unwanted prescription drug collection: Chief Layber and Officers have reviewed the request for the potential of locating a drug collection box in Cottage Grove. Based on his experience from prior department, concern over safety of officers handling materials left in the box, and current availability of drop off locations, he would not recommend pursuing a box

drop off box at the police department. There is a drop off box at the Madison Police Eastside location on Cottage Grove Road as well as our Village Forward Pharmacy collects prescription drugs.

- e. Evacuation drill at Glacial Drumlin School: Chief Layber explained that it had been rescheduled for the fall.
 - f. Bike Patrol: Chief Layber relayed that the department has outfitted the donated bike with the appropriate equipment and an interested officer. They are just awaiting the training to be completed by the officer in order to move ahead with bike patrols.
5. Old Business: No agenda items
6. Chief's Report
- a. Police Department Activity Report: Chief Layber highlighted a few items in the report which was included in the meeting packet and clarified a few items. For example, calls in one portion of the report were by definition incidents in another due to the differing sources of the data. The overall department budget is tracking fine with the notable exception of overage in training. This is an area for consideration as the department and committee develop recommendations for 2020 budget.
 - b. Detective Report: Chief Layber walked through the report noting the high level of activity.
 - c. SRO Report: Chief Layber and committee reviewed the SRO report with members noting the level of involvement and need for the SRO. There was one typo noted that the Chief will address.
 - d. K9 Report: Chief Layber relayed the activities of our K9 unit in the Village and mutual aid outside.

- Discuss potential of solar powered radar traffic signs in certain risk area (i.e. cost; possible location) for consideration of added to the budget
