RE:	2021 Street repaving & Maintenance Plan

BACKGROUND

The budget annually includes money for street repaving. We have used this for two years now to proactively mill and repave our residential streets that are beyond efficient use of maintenance treatments, but still good candidates for new asphalt without complete reconstruction.

The operating budget has funds allocated for street maintenance annually; this is used for preventive maintenance like crack-filling and chipsealing which are proven to extend the useful life of asphalt if applied appropriately and aggressively.

OVERVIEW

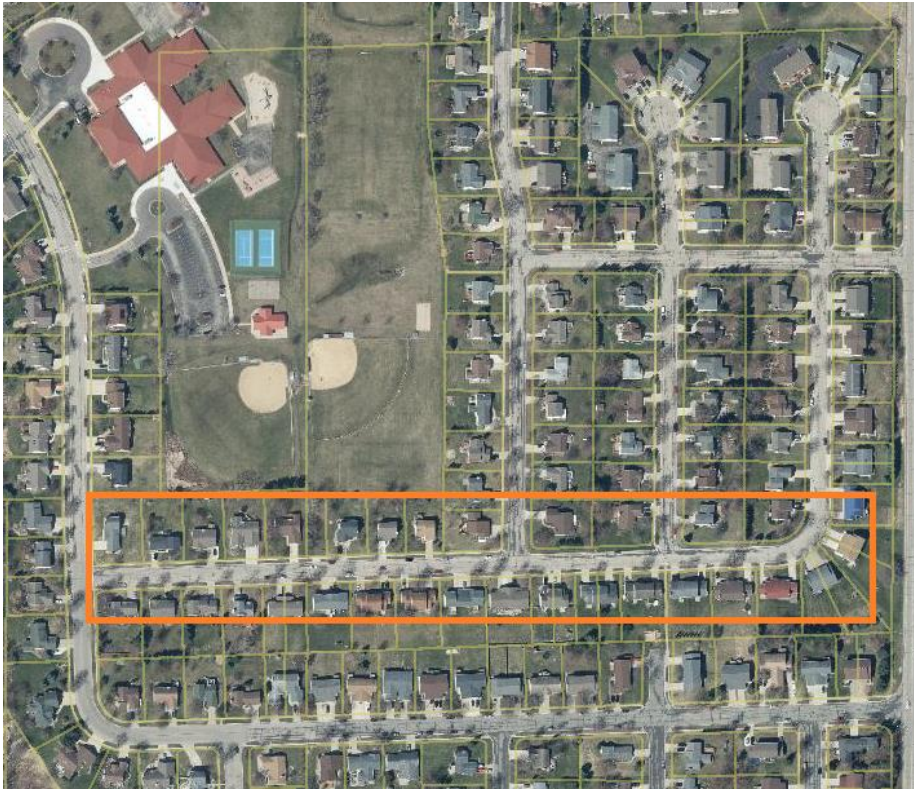
This year, I am proposing to repave W. Clover Ln. from the intersection with N. Parkview to N. Clover Ln. This street has significant alligator-cracking and has required pothole repair over the last few years. It is also an important neighborhood street connecting to Taylor Prairie School, so it sees significant local traffic.

For street maintenance this year we are planning to crack fill, make some small repairs and then chipseal the portions of CTH N/Main St. that are around 10-years old; roughly from School Rd. south near BB and then from BB south to near Reynolds St. The plan is to have the project split into two sections – north of BB and south of BB – and if prices come in high, the work can be completed over a couple of years. Last fall Dane County provided a price to handle the re-striping for the project.
