Cottage Grove Police K9 Monthly Report for May, 2021

✓ **Calls for Service:**

- The K9 and handler responded to the Kwik Trip in the Village for a report of two subjects slumped over and to be unconscious in a vehicle at one of the fuel pumps. Once on scene I was able to awaken both subjects. Both subjects showed physical signs of being on a drug or narcotic. The K9 was detailed around the vehicle and alerted on the vehicle. A search of the vehicle by CGPD Officers resulted in drug paraphernalia for the use of heroin. Also, located within was a small amount of methamphetamine. After interviews one subject was arrested for possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia charges.
- The K9 Unit assisted a CGPD Officer with a vehicle sniff on a traffic stop he conducted. The K9 alerted on the vehicle. Found with an interior search of the vehicle was bits and pieces of marijuana that were embedded in the driver's seat and corners of the interior center console.
- The K9 Unit along with other CGPD Officer's were dispatched to the 500 block of Progress Dr. for a report of a stolen vehicle parked on the side of the road. Once on scene the vehicle was verified to be stolen out of the Village of Oregon. The vehicle was cleared by Officer's and found to be unoccupied. The K9 Unit conducted a track from the stolen vehicle. The K9 tracked across the street to an address with several vehicles in a driveway. No suspect(s) were located. Officer's checked for doorbell video and had no luck. Contact was made at the address where the K9 sniffed the door handles of several vehicles. It was believed the suspect(s) may have been trying the vehicles door handles to steal one. This case is among several other stolen and recovered vehicles the CGPD Detective is investigating.
- The K9 Unit was requested by the Wisconsin State Patrol along with Detectives from the Janesville PD for a vehicle sniff on a vehicle they were conducting surveillance on. The vehicle was stopped in a parking lot in the city of Madison. The K9 alerted on the back-hatch portion, and driver's side front door seam of the stopped vehicle. Drug paraphernalia used for methamphetamine and heroin use was located inside. The driver was arrested by the WSP and transported to the Rock County jail on charges

of possession of paraphernalia and OWI drug driving. It was believed by the Officer's on scene that the arrested party had just sold a large amount of both drugs prior to being stopped.

- The K9 Unit was requested by the Madison Police Department for a vehicle sniff on a traffic stop of theirs. The K9 Unit was disregarded prior to arriving on scene. Consent was given to search the vehicle.
  - The K9 Unit was requested by the Monona Police Department for a vehicle sniff on a traffic stop of theirs. The K9 Unit was disregarded prior to arriving on scene. An arrest was made and a search incident to that arrest was conducted on the vehicle.
  - The K9 Unit was requested by the Wisconsin State Patrol for a vehicle sniff on a traffic stop of theirs. The K9 did not alert on the vehicle after sniffing the air around the exterior of the stopped vehicle.
- ✓ The K9 Unit attended a monthly training at the Steinig Tal Kennels in Cambellsport, WI
