BACKGROUND: See Attachment

OVERVIEW: Suspend ordinance 230-3 stating “Park closing hours. All Village parks shall be closed from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., except for public functions approved by the Village Board or its designee. The Village Board or its designee may approve events or activities within the parks beyond 10:00 p.m. by private organizations or individuals if satisfactory evidence is presented that the event or activities will be carried on so as not to disturb the public peace and good order of the Village. In granting such written approval, the Village Board or its designee shall designate the area in which the function shall be carried on and shall indicate the person responsible for the conduct of such function. No person shall be in any Village park between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. except in compliance with this subsection.” for September 27th, 2019 at Lions Shelter in Fireman’s Park to allow for persons to occupy the park during closed hours for a boy scout camp out.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Suspend ordinance 230-3 on October 2, 2021 to allow for Boy Scout Troop 145 to occupy Lions Shelter at Fireman’s Park during park closed hours.
